Founded in the year 1981 by the great visionary and philanthropist Late Janab Hakeem Abdul Hameed and nurtured by its Honorary Secretary Janab Saiyid Hamid, I.A.S. (Retd.), Hamdard Education Society has taken giant strides in the field of educational upliftment of the weaker sections particularly Muslims. Infrastructure: -

Hamdard Coaching Centre is part of Talimabad Campus situated at Sangam Vihar, only a short distance from Hamdard Nagar, Tughlakabad, New Delhi- 110062 where Jamia Hamdard University is located. The Centre comprises its office, classrooms, library, reading room, recreation room and a furnished hostel. The facility provides a congenial atmosphere for class room learning, self study, mutual interaction, group discussion and competitive spirit.

Competent and experienced faculty from universities and reputed coaching houses are invited. Strategic planning, motivation sessions, counselling and scheduled programme are conducted by the Director.

Admission Procedure:-

Admission form and information bulletin are available from the office of the Hamdard Coaching Centre against payment of Rs. 100.00 by hand or a despatch of Demand Draft of Rs. 150.00 in favour of **Hamdard Education Society payable at New Delhi** by post. The student can also download the application form from Jamia Hamdard University website – www.jamiahamdard.edu and duly filled form alongwith a demand draft of Rs.150.00 in favour of **Hamdard Education Society payable at New Delhi** can be sent.

Instructions for completion and despatch of the Application Form: -

1. Candidates are expected to attach 10th and 12th class mark sheets, and specify their percentage of PCB / PCM in the Application Form.
2. Candidates must attach latest coloured passport size photograph (three copies)
3. The candidates shall fill up the Application Form in his / her own handwriting in BLOCK LETTERS written neatly and legibly with blue / black Ballpoint pen in the prescribed boxes.
4. Overwriting, Cuttings, Erasing in the Application Form may lead to rejection of Form. Any error, arising on this account shall be the responsibility of the candidates.

Screening Test: -

1. There will be objective type questions with four options having single correct answer. For each incorrect response, one third of the total marks allotted to the question would be deducted. More than one answer indicated against a question will be deemed as incorrect response and will be negatively marked.
2. The screening test will be having 40 questions each in Physics , Chemistry and Mathematics for Engineering Stream carrying 360 marks & 50

questions each Physics & Chemistry and 100 questions for Biology carrying 600 marks for Medical stream.

Accommodation arrangement: -

Candidates arriving for the Screening test will be provided accommodation within the campus at Delhi on moderate charges (for boarding and lodging). Separate arrangement exists for Girl candidates.

Declaration of result :-

The Hamdard Coaching Centre will prepare a list of successful candidates in order of merit based on the score obtained in the screening test. The total no of seats available at this coaching centre in each stream are thirty. The result will be displayed at Gate No- 1 of H.P.S. & website - www.jamiahamdard.edu as per notice for declaration of result.

Fees and deposits: -

No fee is charged for coaching. However, following charges are to be paid by the student:-

Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India may provide stipend of Rs. 1500.00 to outstation and Rs. 750.00 to local students who fulfill the conditions stipulated by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India.

Lodging and Boarding: -

Residence at the hostel is compulsory. The students can go out only from gate No- 1 after written permission from the warden and signing the register. They must return

to the hostel before 10.00 p.m. staying out beyond this time will invite disciplinary action. Going out, unless in an emergency, is discouraged as it affects focus on studies.

Boarding facilities are available in the campus, which include two meals, breakfast and evening tea with snacks. Dining and catering facility will remain open as per announced schedule, which must be strictly adhered to. Remission in boarding charges for absence of more than five days is permissible in genuine cases.

Guest:-

There is no provision for entertaining guests in the hostel. Trainees are strictly prohibited from allowing friends / guests in the hostel. Parents and guests can stay, on payment, at the guest house of H.E.S. subject to availability of accommodation.

Coaching Programme: -

The session will commence July 6, each year.

Specified duration wise phase of preparation will be as follows:-

1	Revision of syllabus with orientation towards competitive exams and holding of topic wise tests	July to November
2	Holding of Unit wise tests on the pattern of question papers for preliminary & main exams	October to February
3	Revision by self study	February to March
4	Full syllabus tests	February to March
5	Self study	March to April
6	Holding of full syllabus tests for mains	April to May

Students having less than 100 % attendance will be asked to discontinue the coaching. The lecture sessions will be of two hours duration and there will normally be 2 to 3 sessions per day & 12 sessions in a week. Tests are administered in order to convert their knowledge and skill into marks. The level of tests is gradually raised requiring quick grasp.

Motivation Session: -

Special attention is given to each participant to instill in him / her the spirit of competition, perseverance, hard work and sustained effort.

Difficulty removal session: -

Difficulty removal sessions will be organized by the teaching faculty. The sessions will comprise five contacts per subject spread in four weeks from March to 1st week of May.

The Centre will close its activities on May 31, each year. The students who wish to avail of stipend as sanctioned by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India shall give an undertaking that he / she will not leave the course in between. In the event of such departure without adequate reason, he / she will not be entitled to any Govt. assistance and liable to refund the amount spent on his / her coaching to the Government. The Director reserves the right to strike off from the rolls and send back students who (1) misbehave (2) fail to take the training seriously (3) cause distractions.

Discipline: -

1. In case, the Director is of the opinion that a student is not working hard, is not serious, is creating indiscipline, is irregular in attendance, unwilling to put in hard work, he / she may be asked to withdraw from the coaching centre. The decision of the Director in this regard is final & binding.
2. A student after qualifying in the Screening test and taking admission will be bound by the stipulated norms of the coaching centre.
3. The participants are desired to maintain a high level of discipline. No distractions are permitted. All students are required to adhere to the norms of the centre. In order to secure refund of the security deposit the students will undertake to intimate their result in due course to the Director, Hamdard Coaching Centre.
